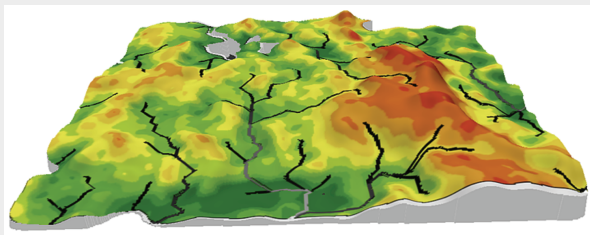


AGHUB SOIL SAMPLING

By focusing on each zone's CEC values, as well as the soil's capability of nutrient uptake, we are able to drive yield in different ways other than just the use of phosphorus and potassium.

SULFUR DEFICIENCIES

Are you noticing some yellowing corn? We are seeing a lot of sulfur deficiencies across our area. Sulfur has become more deficient over the years due to the lack of sulfur in the air and sulfuric rains. Areas with higher sulfur rates are starting to stand out, and we are seeing an impact in yield and overall plant health throughout the growing season.
